ART / Characteristics of art tools and visual impact



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DESCRIPTION

LESSON 1 Each student uses their Logifaces set and starts placing blocks on the table to create various

patterns and structures on the surface. Then they are given A/2 paper sheets and the students place the blocks on the sheet. Using a strong light they direct it onto the structures and illuminate them from one side to cast shadows on the paper. They then draw the silhouette of

the shadow using a pencil.

LESSON 2 They cut the silhouettes out and place them on another A/2 paper sheet (preferably black, or

another colour) to create a pattern or structure. The next task is to glue the cut out shapes on the paper in a chosen rhythm. (The students should use the Logifaces to fill in the gaps and

create patterns with white/light-coloured pencil).

INSPIRATION natural nets, mesh structures, Voronoi diagrams

TECHNIQUE graphics, cutting, crafts

OBJECTIVE Creating a surface pattern from a spatial structure. Linking light/shadow to graphics.

PRIOR KNOWLEDGE

Visual structures, converting spatial structures into patterns
